

NEWTON CENTRAL SCHOOL ENROLMENT ZONE



Applications for out of zone and special enrolment programme close on 5th September in the year preceding enrolment.

Where vacancies are available and applications exceed places available a ballot will be held on the 15th September in the year preceding enrolment.

No applications will be considered after September 5th for the following year. Priority will be given to:

- First Priority** students who have been accepted for enrolment the following special programme(s).
1. Te Reo Maori immersion classes, levels 1-2;
 2. Bilingual / Enrichment classes, level 3;
 3. Orakei Marae Satellite level 2 immersion;
 4. Fanau Pasifika class
- Second Priority** will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.
- Third Priority** will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.
- Fourth Priority** will be given to applicants who are children of board employees.
- Fifth Priority** will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) on the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status will require to give proof of a sibling relationship.
