The successful candidate will be open to learning, prepared to work collaboratively with staff and contribute to a positive working environment. Newton Central School is a Tiriti-based kura with 3 language pathways: Māori medium, Bilingual and Mainstream.

The position is fulltime/ Parttime 5 days a week 9am - 3pm by negotiation. There could be some flexibility in these hours for the right candidate however 4 days will be a minimum requirement.

You will be employed under the Support Staff in Schools Collective Agreement 2022-2024. Start date is negotiable. This is a permanent position.
